His wish is soon to come about through the work of Glenn Tadina and several members from the Salem Concert Band and Portland Metro Band who have diligently worked on the cataloguing project. The project was left in the hands of Glenn Tadina as requested by Robert Duvall's daughter, Amy D.

The Duvall Music Lending Library is about 75% catalogued. The library hosts 2,200 + titles of concert selections and marches which fills eleven four drawer file cabinets and several cardboard boxes. Much of the library is Out of Print material. If you would like to help with the cataloguing, let us know and we will contact you with information as to how you can get involved.

Some of the process of administering the library is still being developed by Amy and Glenn. Funds are currently short for the purchase some needed supplies to complete the project.
